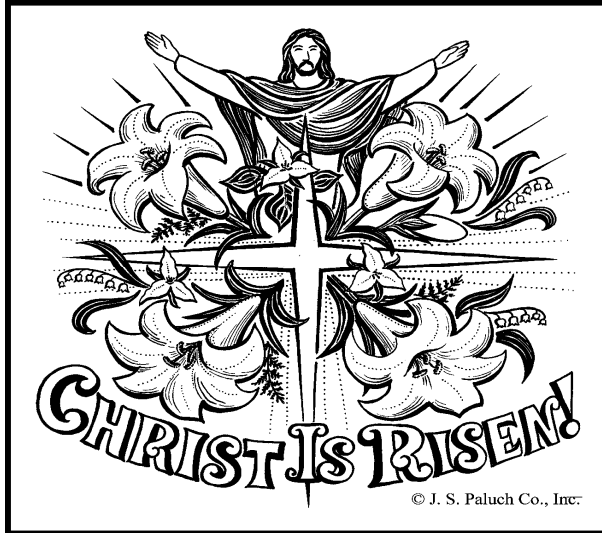

Pastor's Corner

For three years Jesus taught His disciples in parables, performed miracles to show His message of love and His power as the Son of God, and brought the message of the Kingdom of God to thousands of people throughout the country of Israel. Many of His disciples gave up their old ways of life to follow the new way of our Lord and Savior. And, in 2019, we are called to do the same.

On Good Friday many of the leaders turned against Jesus, and many of His followers turned against Him as well. As a result, Jesus suffered His horrible death of crucifixion. But, as we know, the story of Jesus did not end on Calvary. His message of resurrection culminates in what we celebrate today: His rising from the dead!

Some of you may be attending Mass for the first time in a few months, or even years. Others are here every Sunday. Our hope and prayer is that our celebration of Christ's resurrection will touch each of our hearts, so that we feel a call to increase our faith, and to share our gifts with our parish community. As I have said before, for many years I was a "pew potato" just sitting in the church waiting for something to happen. Jesus's resurrection is what makes things happen. It is His invitation to us to walk with Him, to hear His Word, and to live it in our lives.

On the cover of our bulletin is a list of the various ministries that we have here at St. Mark. Perhaps one of these ministries is something that you have considered in the past, but have not pursued. I hope that you will take some time to ask the Lord in prayer to help you discern your gifts and to see how God is calling you to share them.

During this Easter Season, let us recognize our call to be a Resurrection People, as we share the Good News of salvation, the message of eternal life, and the proclamation of the Kingdom of God!
