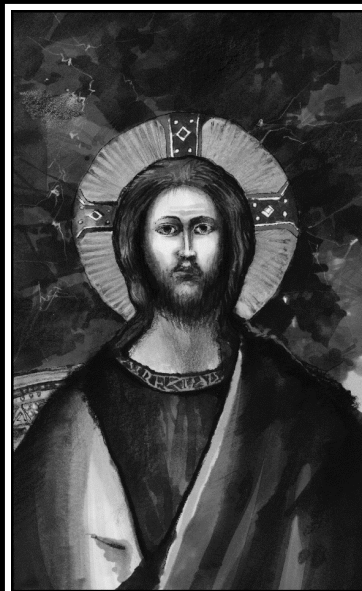

FROM OUR PASTOR

Pastor's Corner

As always, welcome to St. Mark's on this Thanksgiving Weekend. Just a few days ago our country paused to say thank you to our loving and generous God. I hope that you had an opportunity to gather with family and friends. I would like to share this cute but poignant reflection.

Around the Table

"On Thanksgiving a family was seated around their table, looking at the annual holiday bird. From the oldest to the youngest, they were to express their praise. When they came to the 5-year-old in the family, he began by looking at the turkey and expressing his thanks to the turkey, saying although he had not tasted it he knew it would be good. After that rather novel expression of thanksgiving, he began with a more predictable line of credits, thanking his mother for cooking the turkey and his father for buying the turkey. But then he went beyond that. He joined together a whole hidden multitude of benefactors, linking them with cause and effect.

He said, "I thank you for the checker at the grocery store who checked out the turkey. I thank you for the grocery store people who put it on the shelf. I thank you for the farmer who made it fat. I thank you for the man who made the feed. I thank you for those who brought the turkey to the store."

Using his Detective Columbo-like little mind, he traced the turkey all the way from its origin to his plate. And then at the end he solemnly said "Did I leave anybody out?"

His 3-year-old brother, embarrassed by all those proceedings, said, "God." Solemnly and without being flustered at all, the 5-year-old said, "I was about to get to him."

Well, isn't that the question about which we ought to think about at Thanksgiving? Are we really going to get to him this Thanksgiving? I hope that you did, if not, it is not too late!"

Next Weekend we will begin the new Liturgical Year and the beginning of the Season of Advent. It was a year ago that the new Roman Missal was introduced to all the English speaking countries of the world. I shared with you over several weeks special information inserts in our Sunday bulletins. I discussed the changes at our Sunday Masses. To help in the transition period St. Mark's provided a special Mass card with all the changes and responses of the congregation. Overall you, our community, has done very well. There are still a few that forget the changes from time to time but I have confidence that eventually all will be well. The special Mass cards were never intended to remain in the pews as long as they have. On the 1st Sunday of Advent they will have been removed from the church. All the responses are found in the missalettes. As you did before, if you are in need of a written copy of your responses then please refer to the missalette after the cards have been removed. Once again it will take a little readjustment and practice but I have confidence that our community can be successful.

Save the date. Our Advent Penance Service, with additional visiting priests from nearby parishes helping with confessions, is scheduled for Monday, December 10, 2012, at 7:00 p.m.. Please join us for this special evening of reconciliation.

SAFE GUARD THE CHILDREN

Keep holiday parties safe for children

Wine, cocktails and spiked eggnog may make your holidays festive, but they're no party for young children. Children often accidentally drink alcohol after holiday parties, by sampling partially empty glasses and what's left in the punch bowl. Ingesting as little as 3 ounces of hard liquor potentially can be fatal to a child weighing 25 pounds. Alcohol causes blood sugar levels to drop, which can lead to confusion, seizures or even comas. Clear away all glasses and other alcoholic containers immediately as soon as guests leave after your holiday party. Keep the poison control center phone number programmed in your phone and posted on your refrigerator: 1-800-222-1222.

PROTEGIENDO A LOS NIÑOS

Mantenga las fiestas navideñas seguras para los niños

Vino, cócteles, o rompopo con vino pueden hacer que su temporada navideña sea más festiva, pero no para los niños. A menudo, los niños accidentalmente beber alcohol después de las fiestas, tomando de vasos parcialmente vacíos y lo que queda en el tazón de ponche. La ingestión de tan solo 3 onzas de licor fuerte puede ser potencialmente fatal para un niño que pesa 25 libras. El alcohol hace que bajen los niveles de azúcar en la sangre, lo cual puede llevar a confusión, convulsiones e incluso coma. Limpie todos los vasos y otros recipientes que contengan alcohol inmediatamente después de que se termine su fiesta. Tenga el número de teléfono del centro de control de intoxicaciones programado en su teléfono y mantenga el número a la mano en la puerta de su refrigerador: 1-800-222-1222.
